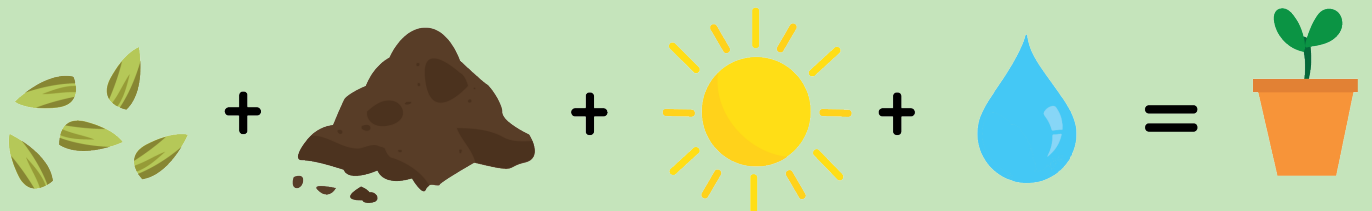

RECIPE FOR GROWING PLANTS

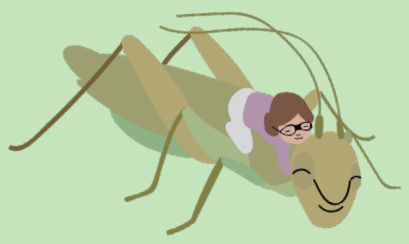


What do you notice about your seed's growth?

 - Magnifying glass

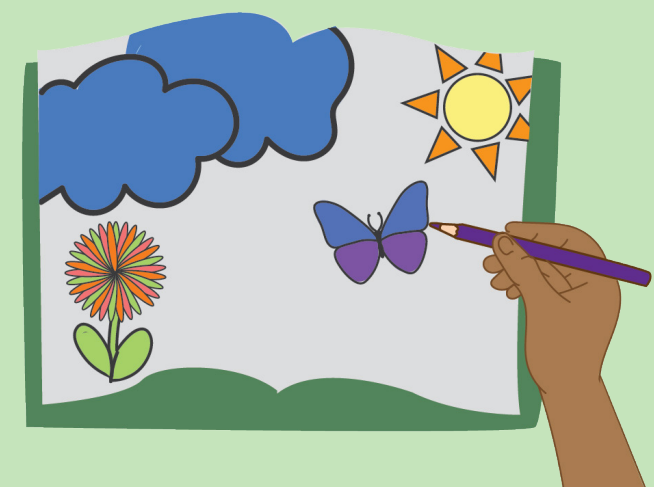
